Background

In the framework of the German-Chilean Energy Partnership a sideevent will be hosted at the German Pavilion at COP25 presenting and discussing "Coal Exit Strategies: Managing Social Implications and Security of Supply".

It will bring together representatives from national and subnational governments and civil society discussing how to make a coal exit socially acceptable, ensuring financial stability and security of supply of the countries in a post-coal era.

At the same time, and against the background of the fact that a number of countries have committed themselves to progressively phasing-out electricity production from coal and lignite, including Germany until 2038, this side-event aims to shed light on developing best-practice strategies for the phasing-out of coal in different countries around the globe.

Guiding Questions

What are the main reasons to phase out coal? How do you insure security of supply and affordability of electricity? How to create a societal consensus for a coal exit, especially in the regions that rely most heavily on coal? Does a phase-out call for a phase-in of something else? Which perspectives are there to transform former coal regions? How to ensure a clear and well-defined phase out process? How were social & economic impacts identified? What is the balance between old/new jobs in affected regions?
